Handling and shipping rates, effective April 1, 2009:

We ship new, high-quality, recently published books. Inquire for our current book list.

One 40-foot container: \$18,000 (includes shipping up to \$6,500, sponsor pays overage)

A 40-foot container typically holds approximately 40,000-42,000 pounds of books. The quantity of books varies widely, depending on sizes of the books selected.

☞ We will invoice the shipment funder for shipping costs that exceed \$US 6500.

One 20-foot container: \$14,500 (includes shipping up to \$5,000, sponsor pays overage)

A 20-foot container typically holds approximately 25,000-27,000 pounds of books. The quantity of books varies widely, depending on sizes of the books selected.

☞ We will invoice the shipment funder for shipping costs that exceed \$US 5000.

Repack fee, per pallet \$500 Invoked when sponsor/recipient changes a book selection resulting in IBB's having to unpack/repack a pallet

Hard-copy documents fee \$50 Invoked when IBB is required to send hard-copy documents by courier service to the shipment recipient

Please note these important requirements:

- Payments must be remitted in US dollars.
- A 25% deposit is required to reserve books in our system and begin packing.
- Payment in full must be made before container(s) can leave warehouse.
- We regret that we are not able to extend credit.
